

- 890 to 940 :
Limestone, beige, granular, clayey
with poor to fair porosity. FORAM.
940 to 1800. Interbedded
Marly Limestone, light grey beige
mod. cons., f to f grained,
glauconitic, fossiliferous, minor pyr.
occasional coarse calc. cristals
Numerous Foram. Bry. shell frag.
and
Calcareous Marl mod. to poorly
cons. (slt), occasional qte grains.
carbonate grains in silt size.
Occasional streaks of white
compact crystallised limestone
with glauconitic grains.

- 1300 to 1925 :
Marl, light to medium grey,
soft, earthy, lumpy, minor
qte silt, rare glauconite.
Presence of Bry, Echinidea
remains, shell frag.
The unit becomes more
clayey and soapy downwards
Below 1690, apparition of
grey greenish clayey marl,
slightly fissile, soft, rich
in fossils debris.

Occasional streaks of marly
Limestone, grey beige to
beige, granular, fine grained,
rich in Echinidea debris
becoming more frequent
below 1750.
