Crossed Nicols (1 mm). Quartz grains embedded in single crystal of carbonate (speckled buff colour) which locally occludes all porosity. A corroded muscovite flake (centre, bright colours) is also shown.

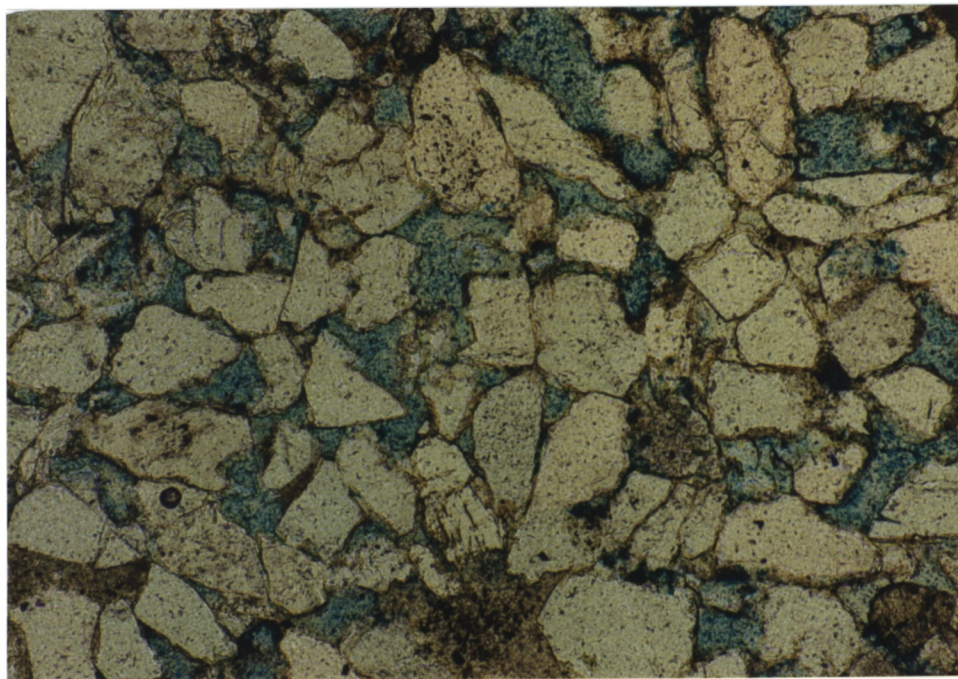


FIGURE 2b: 1814.5 m
